

Q: Are Area meetings not happening any more in the district?

A: No, the district used to have staff organized by Areas, with the new strategic plan Acceleration 2020 that changed. With new geography based Parent Advisory Councils you can attend a meeting near your school, home, or work. These meetings will be family led, staff supported, and open for anyone to attend. They are based on the [Board of Education Districts](#) so there are more opportunities for families to meet, in more locations, and across communities.

Q: Can I attend a PAC meeting near my home?

A: Yes, you can attend any PAC meeting you like, close to your home, where your child goes to school, near your work, or with friends.
