Minimum Standards and Requirements for PACs

- Participation is open to all parents, guardians and community members
- Regularly scheduled meetings with publicly distributed invitation (minimum of 4 meetings per school year)
- Align with MPS Vision “Every child college and career ready”
- PAC Mission Statement that includes how the community they are part of will support Acceleration 2020 and student achievement
- Establish an organizational Charter from a template that will be provided
- District staff member (s) present
- Set norms for meetings, publish agenda, post snapshot notes (see templates)
- Set evaluation structure (how we share the story of the PAC) (OSFCE staff will support this work)
